These appointments allow you to ask questions and become familiar with your baby's doctor ahead of time. Don't worry if you are not quite ready to meet with your baby's new provider; your baby can be assigned one at the hospital at the time of delivery.

Provided at the Hospital

- Newborn screening
- Lactation support
- Recommended medications after delivery:
 - Vitamin K (to assist the baby's immature liver with clotting)
 - Erythromycin (to prevent bacteria from causing blindness)
 - Hepatitis B vaccine (first in a series of 3 to prevent hepatitis B)

Vaccinations

Baby Well-Checks

In the first year, baby well-checks are a routine part of infant care. We plan to see your baby at three to five days of age, two weeks, one/two months, and at four, six, nine, and twelve months.
